



Baggage Allowance On Domestic Flights

To ensure a smooth and comfortable journey across the country, we've compiled essential guidelines for domestic air travel. From ID requirements to baggage rules and airline-specific policies, this reference will help you navigate your internal flights with ease.

Transfers & Delays

1. **Plan for possible delays** — domestic flights can occasionally run late, especially during foggy winter months (**Dec–Jan in North India and the Himalayas**) or the monsoon (**Jun–Sep in the East**).
2. When connecting from a domestic to international flight, leave **at least 3–4 hours buffer**, especially in major airports like Delhi or Mumbai.
3. In safari regions, **ground transfers** can be long — be prepared for **3 to 6 hours of road travel** with limited rest stops.

Airport Arrival & Check-In Guidelines

1. Arrive at the airport **at least 2 hours before departure** to allow time for check-in, security, and possible queues.
2. Airline check-in counters close **45 minutes prior to departure** – guests arriving late may be denied boarding.
3. Boarding gates close **25 minutes before departure**; ensure you reach the gate well in advance.
4. **Peak travel hours** (early mornings, weekends, holidays) can be congested – allow an additional **30–45 minutes buffer time**.
5. Even **smaller regional airports** (e.g. Jabalpur, Jorhat, Pantnagar) may have delays or slower processes – better to be early.

Airport Security & Documentation



1. **Always carry a printed copy** of your flight ticket and passport — while e-tickets are accepted, some smaller airports may request a hard copy.
2. **Visa page and immigration stamp** from your international entry should be readily available, especially if flying again shortly after arrival.
3. If you are on an **e-visa**, keep a printed copy with your passport at all times.
4. After security screening, ensure your **hand baggage is tagged, and the tag is stamped** by security staff. This will be checked again at the boarding gate.
