Four big cats, *one unrepeatable journey*

India is the only country on Earth where all four of the world's great cats can be found in the wild — the Bengal tiger, the common leopard, the Asiatic lion and the elusive snow leopard. This twenty-five day expedition is built to find every one of them, from the fortress-crowned valleys of Ranthambore to the high Himalayan reaches of Ladakh.

Begin among tigers in Ranthambore, then journey into Bera, where leopards share their rocky outcrops with local communities in a rare, living harmony. In Gir, encounter the last wild population of Asiatic lions on Earth — some 800 strong and found nowhere else. The expedition closes above 3,000 metres in Ladakh, tracking the snow leopard, the "mountain ghost," through the valleys around Ulley.

Between the wildlife, the Taj Mahal at sunrise and the palaces of Jaipur add the pageantry of the Golden Triangle. Expert naturalists and specialist trackers lead every safari and expedition, while comfortable lodges carry you seamlessly across the length and breadth of India — a single, unrepeatable portrait of every big cat this country holds.

Four cats, *four wildernesses*

Below, the four wildernesses at the heart of this expedition.



Ranthambore National Park

BENGAL TIGER · DAYS 3–6

1,411 sq. km of rocky hills, valleys and ancient fort ruins in the Aravalli and Vindhya ranges, renowned for frequent daytime tiger sightings and 300 recorded bird species.

Gir National Park

ASIATIC LION · DAYS 11–14

The last wild refuge of the Asiatic lion, home to over 800 individuals — a conservation story beginning with a 19th-century hunting ban by the Nawab of Junagarh.

Bera & Jawai

COMMON LEOPARD · DAYS 7–9

A remote Rajasthani village landscape where leopards inhabit rocky outcrops alongside local communities in rare, enduring harmony, shared with crocodile, blue bull and striped hyena.

Ulley, Ladakh

SNOW LEOPARD · DAYS 17–23

A remote Trans-Himalayan settlement above 3,000 metres, and the base for six days of dawn tracking with expert local spotters in pursuit of the mountain ghost.

Delhi, Agra, Jaipur & *Leh*

Between the four wildernesses, this journey carries you through the monuments and mountain gateways that connect one big cat to the next — Mughal marble, Rajasthani forts and the roof of the world.



New Delhi

GATEWAY CITY · DAYS 1–2, 14–15 & 24–25

India's capital, the departure and return point for the expedition, and the changeover city between its central Indian, Rajasthani and Himalayan legs.

Jaipur

THE PINK CITY · DAYS 6–7

The royal capital of Rajasthan, a brief but vivid stop of palaces and bazaars between the tigers of Ranthambore and the leopards of Bera.

Agra

MUGHAL CAPITAL · DAYS 2–3

Home to the incomparable Taj Mahal, seen at sunrise, and the crescent-shaped ramparts of Agra Fort — the expedition's opening chapter of heritage.

Leh

3,500M · DAYS 15–17 & 23–24

A high-altitude gateway city built around Thiksey Monastery and the Indus River, requiring careful acclimatisation before the final push into snow leopard country.

Delhi, Agra & *Ranthambore*

DAY

01

Arrive in New Delhi

On arrival at New Delhi Airport, our representative greets you, hands over all travel documents and escorts you to your hotel for an overnight stay.

DAY

02

New Delhi – Agra

The 220 km, four-hour drive to Agra, with an afternoon visit to the crescent-shaped ramparts of Agra Fort and its blend of Mughal architecture. Overnight in Agra.

DAY

03

Agra – Ranthambore

Rise before dawn for the Taj Mahal at sunrise, then the 265 km drive to Ranthambore. An afternoon tiger safari on arrival. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

DAYS

04&05

In Ranthambore National Park

Morning and evening tiger safaris through Ranthambore's rocky hills and fortress-crowned valleys, among 300 recorded bird species and some of India's most reliable daytime tiger sightings. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

DAY

06

Ranthambore – Jaipur

A final morning safari, then the 180 km, three-hour drive to Jaipur. Overnight in Jaipur.

Jaipur, Bera & *Gir*

DAY

07

Jaipur – Bera

A 390 km, seven-hour journey through the Rajasthani countryside to Bera, with an evening leopard safari on arrival. Overnight at the lodge.

DAYS

08&09

In Bera

Morning and afternoon leopard safaris across Bera's rocky outcrops, where leopards live in rare harmony alongside village life, shared with crocodile and striped hyena. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

DAY

10

Bera – Ahmedabad

A morning safari, then the 290 km, five-to-six hour drive to Ahmedabad. Overnight in the city.

DAY

11

Ahmedabad – Gir

The 350 km, six-to-seven hour drive to Gir National Park, with an afternoon lion safari on arrival. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

DAYS

12&13

In Gir National Park

Morning and afternoon safaris in search of the Asiatic lion, the last wild population of its kind on Earth, found nowhere else. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

Gir to *the Himalaya*

DAY

I4

Gir – Rajkot – New Delhi

A final morning safari, then the drive to Rajkot Airport for your flight to New Delhi. Check into your hotel on arrival. Overnight in New Delhi.

DAY

I5

New Delhi – Leh

A morning flight to Leh, landing at the military airport (no photography permitted), followed by a short transfer to your hotel. The afternoon is reserved for altitude acclimatisation — rest, hydrate and avoid strenuous activity. Overnight in Leh.

DAY

I6

Leh Sightseeing

Visit Thiksey Monastery, the largest in Leh, then spend the afternoon birdwatching along the Indus River in search of the rare Ibisbill, with an optional evening at the local market. Overnight in Leh.

DAY

I7

Leh – Ulley

A two-and-a-half hour journey through Trans-Himalayan landscapes, past the Sangam confluence of the Indus and Zaskar rivers, before an afternoon snow leopard search on arrival. Overnight at the lodge.

Ulley & *homeward*

DAYS

18–22

In Ulley — Snow Leopard Tracking

Five full days of dawn tracking with the lodge's expert trackers, scanning the mountainsides with spotting scopes and binoculars for the snow leopard, alongside ibex and red fox. Daily meals and overnight stays throughout.

DAY

23

Final Search & Ulley – Leh

A final morning of tracking before the return journey to Leh, with a chance to explore the market on arrival. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY

24

Leh – New Delhi

A leisurely morning before your flight to New Delhi. Check into your hotel on arrival. Overnight in New Delhi.

DAY

25

New Delhi – Fly Back

A leisurely morning before your transfer to the international airport for your onward flight home — four big cats, four wildernesses, and twenty-five days of India now behind you.
