Three cats, *eighteen safaris, one journey*

Sixteen days built around three of India's great cats — the Bengal tiger of Ranthambore, the leopard of Bera, and the Asiatic lion of Sasan Gir, the last wild population of its kind on Earth. Eighteen exclusive jeep safaris, six for each species, give photographers the time and repetition that a real portfolio demands.

In Ranthambore, tigers move through rocky hills and fortress-crowned valleys linked by wildlife corridors to the Keladevi and Sawai Mansingh sanctuaries. In Bera, leopards share sandy outcrops with village life beside the Jawai Dam, in one of India's most unusual predator-human landscapes. In Sasan Gir, over 600 Asiatic lions roam teak and acacia forest found nowhere else in the wild.

Between the three reserves, the Taj Mahal at sunrise and the palaces of Jaipur add a chapter of Golden Triangle heritage. Expert naturalist guides lead every safari in open jeeps built for photography, while comfortable lodges carry you across Rajasthan and Gujarat, without a single detail left to chance.

Ranthambore National Park

BENGAL TIGER · 6 SAFARIS · DAYS 3–7

Rocky hills and fortress-crowned valleys linked by wildlife corridors to the Keladevi and Sawai Mansingh sanctuaries, with over 300 recorded bird species.

Sasan Gir National Park

ASIATIC LION · 6 SAFARIS · DAYS 12–15

Gujarat's teak and acacia forest, the exclusive wild home of over 600 Asiatic lions, alongside Indian gazelle and a thriving population of ungulates.

Jaipur

THE PINK CITY · DAY 7

Amber Fort, City Palace and the Palace of Winds, a single vivid day of Rajasthan's royal heritage between Ranthambore and Bera.

Bera, Rajasthan

COMMON LEOPARD · 6 SAFARIS · DAYS 8–11

A sandy village landscape beside the Jawai Dam, where leopards share rocky outcrops with local communities, alongside crocodile, hyena and migratory birdlife.

Agra

MUGHAL CAPITAL · DAYS 2–3

Home to the incomparable Taj Mahal, seen at sunrise, and the Indo-Islamic ramparts of Agra Fort on the banks of the Yamuna.

Delhi to *Ranthambore*

DAY

01

Arrive in New Delhi

On arrival at New Delhi Airport, our representative greets you, hands over all travel documents and escorts you to your hotel for an overnight stay.

DAY

02

New Delhi – Agra

The 220 km, four-hour drive to Agra, with an afternoon visit to Agra Fort, its Indo-Islamic architecture rising above the Yamuna. Overnight in Agra.

DAY

03

Agra – Ranthambore

Rise before dawn for the Taj Mahal at sunrise, then the 265 km drive to Ranthambore. An afternoon tiger safari in an open jeep on arrival. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

DAYS

04–06

Ranthambore Wildlife Reserve

Morning and afternoon tiger safaris across three consecutive days, through rocky hills and fortress-crowned valleys, among 300 recorded bird species. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

Jaipur & *Bera*

DAY

07

Ranthambore – Jaipur – New Delhi

Visit Amber Fort, the Temple of Kali, the Jantar Mantar observatory, the Hawa Mahal and the City Palace Museum, before the five-hour drive back to New Delhi. Overnight in New Delhi.

DAY

08

New Delhi – Bera

The 390 km, seven-hour drive through the Rajasthani countryside to Bera, checking into Castel Bera or Camp Bera. A late-evening leopard safari through the village landscape. Overnight at the lodge.

DAYS

09 & 10

Bera Leopard Safari

Morning and afternoon leopard safaris across two consecutive days, observing village life and the crocodile basking sites near the Jawai Dam. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

DAY

11

Bera – Ahmedabad

A morning leopard safari, then the 280 km, five-to-six hour drive to Ahmedabad. Hotel check-in and overnight.

Sasan Gir & *homeward*

DAY

I2

Ahmedabad – Sasan Gir

The 350 km, six-to-seven hour drive to Sasan Gir National Park. Lodge check-in, lunch, then an afternoon lion safari. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

DAYS

I3&I4

Sasan Gir Lion Reserve

Morning and afternoon lion safaris across two consecutive days, observing Asiatic lion behaviour alongside Indian gazelle, crocodile and the forest ecosystem they share. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

DAY

I5

Sasan Gir – Rajkot – New Delhi

A final morning safari, then the three-hour drive to Rajkot Airport for your evening flight to New Delhi. Overnight in New Delhi.

DAY

I6

New Delhi – Fly Back

A leisurely morning before your transfer to the international airport for your onward flight home, three cats and eighteen safaris' worth of photographs close behind you.
